



Commercial Pilot Licence – Information Pack

Duration:

To complete a commercial pilot license studying full time and starting with no other experience should take approximately 10 -12 months.

Requirements:

Age – The minimum age to fly solo is 16 years, however you may start dual instruction at an earlier age if you wish. To hold a Private Pilots License you must be at least 17 years old and you must be 18 years old to hold a Commercial Pilots License. While you remain medically fit, there is no upper age limit.

Education – There are no minimum educational requirements, however a good standard of English and Maths is recommended.

Medical – A Class 1 medical certificate is required. It is a good idea for those contemplating going on to commercial aviation to undertake a medical prior to getting too far into your training. The examination is carried out by specialist doctors throughout the country.

Flying Hours – The CAA requires a minimum of 200 hours flight experience for a CPL. This is comprised of...

- 100 Pilot in command
- 30 hours cross country flying
- 10 hours instrument flying
- 10 hours night flying

Exams:

These exams need to be completed before a CPL flight test. Exams can be studied for on your own with help from your instructor, or you can attend the courses that are available on request.

CPL Subjects...

- Air Law
- Meteorology
- Principles of Flight
- Aircraft Technical Knowledge
- Air Navigation
- Human Factors

Privileges of a CPL:

As a CPL you are able to fly for remuneration anywhere in the country.

Course Costs:
