



## Single/Multi Instrument Rating – Information Pack

### Duration:

6 – 8 weeks full time or up to 6 months part time

### Requirements:

**License** – You must hold a current pilots license, either PPL or CPL.

**Education** – There are no minimum educational requirements, however a good standard of English and Maths is recommended.

**Medical** – A class 1 medical certificate is required. The examination is carried out by specialist doctors throughout the country. PPL's may hold a Class 2 medical but must meet the hearing standards of a Class 1.

**Flying Hours** – The CAA requires the following minimum flight experience

- 50 hours cross country pilot in command
- 10 hours instrument cross country under IFR
- 40 hours instrument time
- Must hold a night rating valid to the license

### Exams:

These exams need to be completed before a I/F flight test. Exams can be studied on your own with help from your instructor, or you can attend the courses that are available on request.

I/F Subjects...

- Instrument and Navigation Aids
- Instrument Law
- Instrument Navigation

### Course Costs:

The cost of an instrument rating ranges varies depending on if it is done in a single or multi engine aircraft.

Discounts on flying hours can be offered for payments made in advance.
